Daniel Neindorf ran his beautiful 1972 Dodge Challenger for the first time in Street Outlaws clocking a 11.45 @ 116mph and Super Street racer Vic Veljanovski was back with his HG Kingswood improving with an 11.66 @ 116mph. George Haddad also drove his revamped Falcon to a 10.93 @ 127mph!

Street Outlaw Mod regular Brandon Zito bought his LJ Torana out to play, improving again with a 9.72 @ 139mph, with some good reactions we predict he will be one to watch come Boxing Day!
