

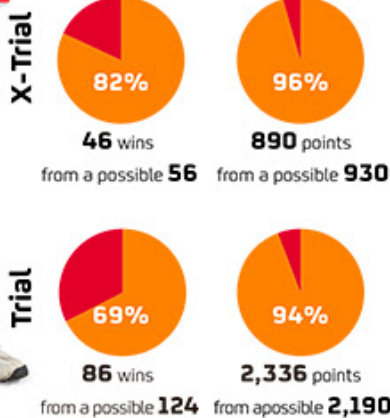
The figures behind Toni Bou's twentieth World Championship title

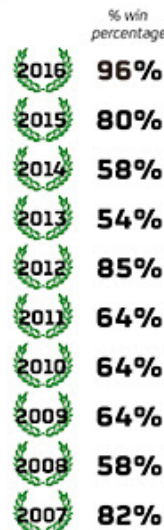
